Peer review under pressure

- Over the last 10 years: increase in number of grant proposals
- Burden on shoulders of scientists
- Time spent by researchers on preparing his/her application
- Value of peer review when dealing with economic or societal impact?



Three conferences hosted by NWO

April: national work conference

May: internal NWO meeting

June: international conference





Why these meetings?

- Success rates for applicants are-too low
- Available budget for NWO has increased... but so has the number of applicants!
- Time spent by researchers on preparing his/her application
- Peer review must be critically examined: are the 'traditional' methods still sound methods?
- Request from the Dutch minister of Education, Culture & Research to NWO:
 - think about alternative methods of evaluating research proposals
 - consider the implementation of one or more experiments



Purpose international conference

- Discuss and exchange knowledge and experiences about issues related to peer review:
 - How can we solve the problems concerning the high number of applications?
 - Which ideas are useful?
 - Should we implement them and if so: how?
