Vision for chemistry; making a stand for fundamental sciences

- On 16 October 2020 the KNAW has presented their <u>report 'Rolling grants'</u> to minister Van Engelshoven.
 The report advocates for more structural funding for scientists throughout their carreer. NWO is supportive of these grants in combination with the existing competitive grants.
- On 15 October 2020 the Table Chemistry presented the <u>Vision for Chemistry 2040</u> to the NWO Science Domain Board.
- The website of the Dutch Chemistry Council, http://dutchchemistrycouncil.nl/, will be launched soon.
 Here, a pamphlet will be posted advocating for more funding for fundamental research.

Funding news

- The NWO Open Competitions instruments ENW Klein and ENW Groot have been developen and will
 continue as ENW-M and ENW-M. respectively. ENW KLEIN-0 will continue as ENW-M-invest.
- The incentive grants for women in STEM are still available.
- The ERC budget for 2021-2026 will be cut by 10%. This decision has shaken the academic world. Link
- NWO's new PPP funding instrument KIC has developed new calls on four main routes: 1. <u>Mission Driven calls</u> 2. <u>Partnerships</u> (opens soon) 3. <u>Long-Term Programs</u> and 4. <u>Practice-oriented instruments</u>. One of the mission-driven calls especially interesting for this community is the <u>Key Technology call</u>.
